Nurses dress and wrap the Angel Babies to present to their Parents to hold while they say their goodbyes. I would never have realized this, as I have no first or secondhand experience of this tragedy. It is estimated that there is an average of 4-5 still births weekly at OHSU. The nursing team also serves at other Portland Metro Area Hospitals/Birthing centers.

Soft Baby Yarn in pink, blue, green, yellow or combo are preferred. Hats should fit snug on a soda can. Any excess supply will also be gifted to surviving Preemie Babies. Veteran, Auxiliary Sister, Dept Guard and Auxiliary Outreach Chairman Darlene Wisdom had noted that an excellent way to serve our homeless/underserved Female Vets would be to provide Feminine Hygiene Kits/Bundles. Pads, tampons, wipes, incontinent pads/underwear are all rising in price and not readily provided at Veteran Resource Facilities/Projects. So many are without, leading to preventable health complications from poor sanitation.
